Individuals in the Portland Metro area can drop their waste polystyrene (Recycle Number 6) at the Agilyx Tigard Plant, 7904 SW Hunziker Street, Tigard, OR 97223.

Improperly discarded plastic waste causes degradation of both land and marine environments. In their 2015 report “*Stemming the Tide*”, the Ocean Conservancy estimates that by 2025, unless plastic waste is properly managed, there will be 1 ton of plastic in the ocean for every 3 tons of finfish.
